| 8 | WHEREAS, it is rightful that this body honor those suffering from sepsis and its |
| 9 | after effects by bringing awareness to the issue in hopes of finding a cure; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, this body thanks Mr. Darrell Raikes, a survivor of sepsis, for his work |
| 11 | to bring awareness and research for the illness; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, Mr. Darrell Raikes is now a sepsis advocate by giving presentations |
| 13 | throughout our Commonwealth and helping others cope with the lingering problems from |
| 14 | this traumatic experience; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, not only during the month of September, but throughout the entire |
| 16 | year, it is important that we continue spreading awareness of this medical condition |
| 17 | across our Commonwealth in hopes of preventing future suffering; |
